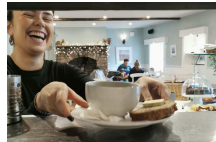
## CHARLES DICKENS - A CHRISTMAS CAROL

## John Paul White

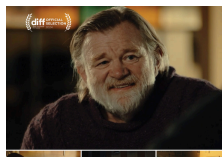


**Saturday 26th October | 20:30**
