


ROB HERON AND THE TEAPAD ORCHESTRA


THE HAAR



THE EASTER SNOW GALLERY

Title: Art Exhibition by Tiffani Love "Footpaths" Date: Sunday 23rd February- 6th April 2025



Tiffani is an artist from New York who is now living and working in the West of Ireland. Her artistic practice involves researching her local landscape and coastline along the shores of the Atlantic in Clare and Galway through repeatedly walking the terrain. In the studio, Tiffani's paintings navigate the spaces where water, earth and atmosphere meld, using paint to explore how the body responds to these places while moving through them.

Tiffani Love's exhibition 'Footpaths' at the Séamus Ennis Arts Centre, Naul, quietly explores the landscapes of the West of Ireland, from a snowcovered Burren limestone, to the rust-red banks of Killary Fjord and the mountains of Donegal's Glenveagh. Her practice, rooted in walking and direct engagement with the terrain, translates the subtle shifts of nature into visual form through oil painting.

The Easter Snow Gallery is open to the public daily from 10.00 a.m-4.00 p.m. All of our exhibitions can be viewed in full online.
